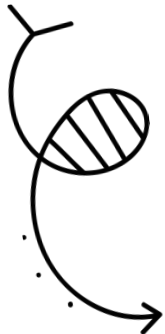
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IEP OBJECTIVES:

Personal Space (foundational skills)

1. After reading or attending to a social narrative regarding personal space, student will answer wh questions about the material for 70% of trials.
2. After reading or attending to a social narrative regarding personal space rules, student will state the personal space rules for family, friends, acquaintances, and strangers for 3 of 4 data probes.
3. Given videos or photographs, student will make their best guess as to if the people are friends, family, strangers or acquaintances based upon their personal space interactions for 75% of trials.
4. Given videos or photographs of personal space infractions, student will a) identify the personal space issue and b) predict a possible outcome for the situation, both for 75% of trials.

IEP OBJECTIVES:

Personal Space (foundational skills)

1. Given names of peers and other people in the student's life, student will a) state what group they fall into: family, friends, acquaintances or strangers), and b) provide the personal space rule that applies to them, both for 70% of trials.
2. Given videos or photographs of a person reacting to a personal space invasion, student will a) identify plausible feelings or thoughts the person might be having and b) signs/evidence (verbal, nonverbal) of these feelings, both for 75% of trials.
3. Given pictures and videos, student will state the plausible exception to personal space rules (cramped conditions at school, posing for a photograph, waiting rooms etc.) for 70% of trials.

IEP OBJECTIVES:

Personal Space

1. Given a peer or adult in proximity, Student will maintain appropriate personal space with no more than 2 gestural or visual reminders for 4 of 6 data probes as measured by SLP observation.
2. By the end of the reporting period, the student will show the ability to practice understanding of personal space rules by maintaining an appropriate distance from peers and adults in 4 out of 5 observed instances.
3. By the end of the academic year, the student will respect others' personal space by asking for permission before entering their space in 4 out of 5 observed instances.
